

What needs to be at vet at time of Spay/Neuter

1. **Spay/Neuter**
2. **Microchipping -using Solas Rescue provided microchips** at the vet *** This only applies to Completely Cat Clinic and Valley View
3. **Rabies Vaccination** – if over 12 weeks
4. **FIV/Feline Leukemia testing**

*** Preferred to have this done ahead of time by Solas Rescue. **Only do it at the vet as a last resort!**

**FIV/Feline Leukemia testing must be done prior to vetting -contact Sarah or your foster mentor to arrange this. If this can't be done, then the vet will have to do the testing.

**All cats must be microchipped. If you are using a vet that does NOT store Solas microchips, please contact Sarah or your foster mentor to arrange this being done by Solas.

Any cat over 16 weeks old is **REQUIRED to have their rabies vaccination prior to adoption. Cats younger than this will be issued a voucher for the adopter to get the vaccine completed. Rabies **CAN** be done at 12 weeks.
